- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state board for
- 2 career and technical education; to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-06 of the
- 3 North Dakota Century Code, relating to counselor position requirements; to provide an effective
- 4 date; and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the state board for career and technical education for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the state board for career and technical education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

13	SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - FEDERAL FISCAL STIMULUS FUNDS -

16	spend any additional federal funds received under the federal American Recovery and			
17	Reinvestment Act of 2009, for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act and			
18	ending June 30, 2011.			
19	Any federal funds appropriated under this section are not a part of the agency's 2011-13			
20	base budget.	Any program expenditures made with these funds will not be replaced with state		
21	funds after the federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 funds are no longer			
22	available.			
23	SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 2 of this Act becomes effective on July 1,			
24	2010.
