- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 43-11-08; and to amend and
- 2 reenact subsection 4 of section 43-41-02 and subsection 4 of section 43-41-04 of the North
- 3 Dakota Century Code, relating to the practice and licensing of social work.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 43-41-02 of the North Dakota

Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

4. a. Nothing in this chapter prevents the employment of social work designees by

- 4. <u>a.</u> Nothing in this chapter prevents the employment of social work designees by hospitals, basic care facilities, or skilled nursing facilities, provided these persons work under the direction of a social worker or social work consultant licensed under this chapter.
 - <u>b.</u> This subsection is ineffective after July 31, 2009, except as to individuals so employed on that date, for so long as that employment continues.
- **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 4 of section 43-41-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 4. The board shall issue a license as a licensed independent clinical social worker to an applicant who:
 - a. Has a doctorate or master's degree in social work from a college or university.
 - b. Has passed an examination approved by the board for this purpose.
 - c. Has satisfied the board that within a four-year period the applicant has successfully completed within four years, three thousand hours of post-master's clinical social work experience under the supervision of a licensed certified social worker who has two years of experience, a licensed independent clinical social worker, or, if an applicant began the supervised clinical social work experience before August 1, 2009, a licensed certified

1		social worker who has two years of experience, a licensed psychologist with a
2		doctorate degree, or a licensed psychiatrist.
3	d.	Has satisfied the board that the applicant agrees to adhere to the code of
4		social work ethics adopted by the board.
