- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to exempting information regarding individuals applying for certain
- 3 university system positions from open records requirements.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. Chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Commissioner and higher education institution president employment applications - Exempt records.

- 1. Records that would identify an individual applying for or under consideration for employment or appointment as the commissioner of higher education or president of an institution under the control of the state board of higher education are exempt from the provisions of section 44-04-18 and section 6 of article XI of the constitution of North Dakota as provided in this section.
- 2. If a search process for commissioner of higher education or president of an institution under the control of the state board of higher education requires selection by the board or board search committee of five or more semi-finalists followed by selection of finalists from among the semi-finalists, records of all applicants or candidates under consideration are exempt prior to selection of the semi-finalists. Selection of semi-finalists means the board or a board search committee selects at least five applicants or candidates for public interviews by the board or board search committee, followed by public interviews by the board of finalists selected from the semi-finalists. The requirement to select at least five semi-finalists is satisfied if five applicants or candidates are selected and publicly

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- identified a semi-finalists, even if one or more of the semi-finalists subsequently withdraws from consideration.
 - 3. Prior to selection of the semi-finalists, all records relating to all candidates are exempt, except the board or board search committee upon request must disclose information regarding the number of applicants or candidates. Following selection of the semi-finalists, all records relating to applicants or candidates not selected as semi-finalists are exempt.
 - 4. Following selection of a group of five or more semi-finalists, all records relating to the semi-finalists and final candidates must be deemed to be public records.
 - 5. The process adopted by the board under this section may include an opportunity for the board to consider an additional candidate or candidates not selected as a semi-finalists if all records relating to a candidate are deemed open records immediately upon action by the board to consider a candidate and the action is not taken for the purpose of avoiding the requirements of this section.
 - 6. The board or a board search committee may go into executive session according to the process established in section 44-04-19.2 to consider or discuss exempt records or the identity of an applicant or candidate whose records are exempt under this section.
