5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 44-08-04 of the North Dakota 6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

7	2.	For travel within the state, the following rates for each quarter of any
8		twenty-four-hour period must be used:

- First quarter is from six a.m. to twelve noon and the sum must be five dollars. 9 a. 10 First quarter reimbursement may not be made if travel began after seven a.m.
- 11 Second quarter is from twelve noon to six p.m. and the sum must be seven b. 12 dollars and fifty cents.
- 13 Third quarter is from six p.m. to twelve midnight and the sum must be twelve C. 14 dollars and fifty cents.
- 15 d. Fourth quarter is from twelve midnight to six a.m. and the sum must be the 16 actual lodging expenses not to exceed fifty-five dollars plus any additional 17 applicable state or local taxes. A political subdivision may reimburse an 18 elective or appointive officer, employee, representative, or agent for actual 19 lodging expenses. A state agency or institution may reimburse an officer, 20 employee, representative or agent for actual lodging expenses exceeding 21 fifty-five dollars based on verification as prescribed by the agency or 22
