**SENATE BILL NO. 2117**

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 43-30-02 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code, relating to exception from licensure as a private investigative or private security  
3 officer.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 43-30-02 of the North Dakota  
6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 7 1. Any investigator or officer directly employed by ~~or under any direct contract with~~  
8 the federal government, state, or any county or city thereof, appointed, elected, or  
9 contracted with, by due authority of law, while engaged in the performance of  
10 official duties. ~~Subcontractors of agencies directly contracted with these entities~~  
11 ~~are not exempted.~~ A licensed peace officer or auxiliary officer employed by a law  
12 enforcement agency may not work as a security officer unless:  
13 a. The officer's law enforcement agency has been contracted to provide security  
14 with all remunerations paid directly to that agency; or  
15 b. The officer is employed by a private security service licensed under this  
16 chapter and the officer is registered as required by this chapter.
