Sixty-first Legislative Assembly of North Dakota

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study workers' compensation laws in 2 this state and other states with respect to prior injuries, pre-existing conditions, and 3 degenerative conditions. 4 WHEREAS, under North Dakota Century Code Section 65-02-30, Workforce Safety and 5 Insurance is required to undergo a biennial independent performance evaluation to determine. 6 among other things, whether the agency is providing quality service in an efficient and 7 cost-effective manner; 8 WHEREAS, an element of the 2008 performance evaluation focused on claims for 9 benefits by injured workers who have degenerative conditions; 10 WHEREAS, the 2008 performance evaluation included conclusions indicating that none 11 of the claims reviewed which involved pre-existing or degenerative conditions were 12 inappropriately denied, but that North Dakota law "is more conservative than most other 13 jurisdictions as it relates to prior injuries, pre-existing or degenerative conditions, triggers and 14 aggravations"; 15 WHEREAS, the performance evaluation also recommended the creation of a study 16 group of all the stakeholder groups to review how other jurisdictions' statutes handle those 17 issues: OF 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE NORTH DAKOTA, THE CONCURRING THEREIN: 19 20 That the Legislative Council study workers' compensation laws in this state and other 21 states with respect to prior injuries, pre-existing conditions, and degenerative conditions; and 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and 23 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 24 the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
