1 A BILL for an Act to provide for an appropriation to the state department of human services for

2 the purpose of contracting with a statewide provider of charitable food distribution services to

3 address gaps in service in, expand the recovery and distribution of surplus food supplies for,

4 and strengthen the capacity of, the North Dakota charitable emergency feeding network.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the 7 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$350,000, or so much 8 of the sum as may be necessary, to the state department of human services for the purpose of 9 contracting with a statewide provider of charitable food distribution services to address gaps in 10 service in, expand the recovery and distribution of surplus food supplies for, and strengthen the 11 capacity of, the North Dakota charitable emergency feeding network, for the biennium 12 beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. The department of human services shall 13 contract with a statewide charitable food recovery and distribution organization to develop and 14 implement new methods of delivering charitable food assistance services in underserved 15 counties, to include a mobile food pantry program and pre-packed food basket program; 16 expand the recovery of surplus food from the retail and wholesale food industry for distribution 17 to charitable feeding programs; provide training, technical assistance and equipment grants to 18 community food pantries and emergency meal programs; and to develop a cross-referral 19 system between charitable feeding programs and government assistance programs that help 20 clients achieve self-sufficiency.
