## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 2 of section 51-33-04 of the North Dakota 6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - A consumer reporting agency that receives a request from a consumer to temporarily lift a freeze on a consumer credit file under this section shall comply with the request no later than three business days fifteen minutes after receiving the request.
- 11 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act becomes effective May 1, 2009.
- 12 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
