- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 6-08.4 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the powers of an industrial bank; and to provide an effective date.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 6-08.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Powers of industrial bank. No industrial bank may accept deposits or make loans at a
- 7 commercial location unless the industrial bank is owned by a financial holding company as
- 8 <u>defined in 12 U.S.C. sec. 1841(p)</u>. For the purposes of this section a "commercial location"
- 9 means a location owned, operated, leased, or otherwise controlled by an entity that derives
- 10 <u>fifteen percent or more of its annual gross revenues, on a consolidated basis, including all</u>
- affiliates of the entity, from engaging, on an ongoing basis, in activities that are not financial in
- 12 nature or incidental to a financial activity during at least three of the prior four calendar quarters,
- 13 as determined by the department of financial institutions.
- 14 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act becomes effective immediately upon its
- 15 filing with the secretary of state.
