- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 6-08 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the assessment of automated teller machines access fees for foreign
- 3 cardholder transactions.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 6-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 created and enacted as follows:

7 <u>Automated teller machines - Definitions - International charges.</u>

- 8 <u>1.</u> In this section:
- 9a."Automated teller machine" means any electronic information processing10device or electronic funds transfer facility located in this state that accepts or11disposes cash in connection with a credit, deposit, or other account.12"Automated teller machine" does not include a device that is used solely to13facilitate check guarantees or check authorizations, or that is used in14connection with the acceptance of dispensing of cash on a person-to-person15basis.
- 16b."Foreign account" means an account with a financial institution located17outside the United States.
- An agreement to operate or share an automated teller machine may not prohibit an
 owner or operator of the automated teller machine from imposing on an individual
 who conducts a transaction using a foreign account an access fee or surcharge
 that is not otherwise prohibited under federal or state law.
- 223.This Act first applies to agreements entered into, modified, or renewed after the23effective date of this section.
