1	A concurrent resolution supporting efforts to make prescription drugs more affordable and
2	urging Congress to take the necessary actions to improve access to affordable prescription
3	drugs for all Americans
4	WHEREAS, Americans pay the highest prices in the world for prescription drugs.
5	WHEREAS, Too many Americans have trouble affording prescription drugs and resort to
6	going without needed medication, skipping doses or splitting pills.
7	WHEREAS, Lack of access to affordable prescription drugs negatively affects the health
8	of many who suffer from chronic illness, particularly the more than 46 million Americans who
9	lack any form of drug coverage.
10	WHEREAS, Allowing Americans access to lower priced prescription medicine from
11	other countries would save billions by introducing price competition into the market place for
12	prescription drugs.
13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
14	HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
15	That the Sixty-first Legislative Assembly supports efforts to make prescription drugs
16	more affordable and urges the Congress of the United States to take necessary actions to
17	improve access to affordable prescription drugs for all Americans; and
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this
19	resolution to each member of the north Dakota congressional delegation.
