8	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
9	HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
10	That the Sixty-first Legislative Assembly urges the Congress of the United States to
11	require that the United States Department of Interior make use of volunteers to reduce the
12	projected elk overpopulation at the Theodore Roosevelt National Park, and allow volunteers to
13	dispose of the elk meat.
