1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section of the North Dakota Century Code, relating

2 to medical facilities giving notice to the public of hospitalist programs and payments for ratings.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. A new section of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted
5 as follows:

Any medical facility in the state of North Dakota must disclose the following information
to the public in the following manner:

- If the medical facility has a mandatory hospitalist program, the facility must publish
 a semi-annual legal notice generally explaining the program including that the
 patient's other treating physicians have no treatment authority.
 If the medical facility places a newspaper advertisement or poster larger than one
- 12 hundred forty-four (144) square inches or displays a public banner larger than ten
- 13 (10) square feet, the facility must include, as a minimum, an abbreviated notice as
 14 required in subsection 1.
