- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 11-11-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the time and place of county commission meetings.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 11-11-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 11-11-05. Meetings of board Time and place. The board of county commissioners
 shall meet and hold sessions for the transaction of business at the courthouse, or at the usual
- 8 place of holding court, on a consistent day of the week in the first week of January, April, July,
- 9 and October of each year, and may adjourn such meetings from time to time. The county
- 10 auditor shall have power to call special sessions when the interests of the county demand it.
- 11 The chairman of the board, or a majority of the members thereof, may call special sessions
- 12 upon giving five days' notice of the time and object of the meeting by publishing the notice in
- 13 the official newspaper of the county, or by giving personal notice, in writing, to all the members
- 14 of the board.
