- 2 Century Code, relating to reapplication for workers compensation disability benefits.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 65-05-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - When disability benefits are discontinued, the organization may not begin payment 1. again unless the injured employee files a reapplication for disability benefits on a form supplied by the organization. In case of reapplication, the award may commence no more than thirty days before the date of reapplication. Disability benefits must be reinstated upon proof by the injured employee that: the injured employee has, as a result of the compensable injury, suffered a loss of earnings capacity of at least ten percent of the employee's preinjury wage for a period of at least five consecutive calendar days duration.
    - The employee has sustained a significant change in the compensable medical condition;
    - The employee has sustained an actual wage loss caused by the significant change in the compensable medical condition; and
  - The employee has not retired or voluntarily withdrawn from the job market as <del>C.</del> defined in section 65-05-09.3.
