- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 43-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to severed interest abstracts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 43-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- Severed interest abstracts upon request. Upon request, an abstracter shall furnish
 an abstract to title to the surface of any tract of land omitting all severed interests, including
 easements, except for the initial document severing the interest from the surface. In addition
 and upon request, an abstracter shall furnish a list showing the names of the grantor and
 grantee and the recording data of all instruments in the chains of title which transfer or convey
 severed interests and which are not included in the surface abstract. For each instrument
 searched and listed, but not included in the surface abstract, an abstracter may charge a fee of
- 13 up to one dollar and fifty cents.
