<sup>3</sup> This amendment provides a contingent general fund appropriation of \$1 million from the general fund for domestic violence grants to the extent that federal funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 are not available.

<sup>4</sup> This amendment removes the 1FTE position authorized in the bill.
