HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.

1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the safety of cosmetics.
2	WHEREAS, some ingredients in cosmetics have caused negative physical reactions in
3	people, from allergic reactions to cancer and reproductive toxicity; and
4	WHEREAS, cosmetic products are most heavily used by women of childbearing age,
5	increasing the likelihood of exposing mothers, fetuses, and nursing children to substances that
6	can cause cancer and reproductive toxicity; and
7	WHEREAS, alternatives to carcinogenic and toxic substances are readily available for
8	use in cosmetic products; and
9	WHEREAS, outdated cosmetics have been known to cause serious infection; and
10	WHEREAS, cosmetics are used by many people in this state and are largely
11	unregulated at the state and federal level; and
12	WHEREAS, other states have adopted safe cosmetics laws to provide lists of
13	ingredients and ingredients identified as causing cancer and other harms;
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
15	OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
16	That the Legislative Council study the safety of cosmetics; and
17	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
18	recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations to
19	the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
