- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 4-37-02 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the agriculture in the classroom council.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 4-37-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 4-37-02. Agriculture in the classroom council.
  - 1. An agriculture in the classroom council is established. The council consists of sixteen members to be appointed by the agriculture commissioner. One member must be the agriculture commissioner or the commissioner's designee, and one member must be the superintendent of public instruction or the superintendent's designee. Agriculture in the classroom grant recipients are nonvoting members of the council:
    - a. The agriculture commissioner or the commissioner's designee;
    - b. One individual appointed by the superintendent of public instruction;
    - one individual appointed by the state board for career and technical education;
    - d. One individual appointed by the governing body of the North Dakota farm bureau;
    - e. One individual appointed by the governing body of the North Dakota farmers union;
    - f. One individual appointed by the governing body of the North Dakota future
      farmers of America;
    - g. One individual appointed by the North Dakota ag coalition;

1 One individual appointed by the director of the North Dakota state university h. 2 extension service; and 3 <u>i.</u> Three teachers appointed for a term of two years by the agriculture 4 commissioner. Recipients of agriculture in the classroom grants may serve as ex officio nonvoting 5 <u>2.</u> 6 members of the council. 7 The three teachers appointed under subdivision i of subsection 1 may serve no 3. 8 more than three consecutive terms. 9 The council shall provide for the election of a chairman from among its members <u>4.</u> 10 and shall adopt rules of operation and procedure.
