1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a transportation voucher program; and to provide an

2 appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. <u>Voucher program.</u> <u>Within legislative appropriation, the department of</u>

5 transportation may provide, contract with a third party, or provide grants to a third party to

6 administer a transportation voucher program. The program must provide assigned checks to

7 eligible participants for the payment of fees or reimbursement of mileage to transportation

8 providers. An assigned check may be used to defray the costs of a ride provided by a volunteer

9 driver or an existing transportation system. To be eligible, a participant must have a

10 documented disability and an identifiable barrier to transportation.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$220,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, and from special funds the sum of \$780,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of transportation for the purpose of creating and administering a transportation voucher system to increase ridership for individuals with disabilities for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.
