- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 48-01.2 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to public building efficiency standards; and to amend and reenact
- 3 section 54-44.5-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the duties of the division of
- 4 community services.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 48-01.2 is created:
- 7 **Public buildings energy efficiency standards.** The division of community services of
- 8 the department of commerce shall adopt rules for construction standards that are consistent
- 9 with or exceed the silver building rating of the leadership in energy and environmental design's
- 10 rating system for new commercial construction and major renovation projects, as established by
- 11 the United States green building council. Any public improvement that is new building
- 12 construction in excess of five million dollars or a modification of an existing structure in excess
- 13 of two million dollars must comply with the rules adopted under this section. The division must
- 14 provide for an exemption from these construction standards for any public improvement for
- 45 which a written analysis is provided that proves that the cost of compliance significantly
- 16 outweighs the benefits.
- 17 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-44.5-04 is amended:
- 18 **54-44.5-04. Division of community services Powers and duties.** The division of
- 19 community services shall:
- 20 1. Provide relevant information on pertinent topics and issues which relate to public
- 21 policy development, interpretation, modification, and implementation.
- 22 2. Research, analyze, and recommend public policy for the office of management and
- 23 budget and the executive office.

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- 1 3. Coordinate public policy implementation within the state. Powers conferred upon 2 departments, agencies, or instrumentalities of the state, counties, townships, or 3 cities by any existing state or local law may not be derogated by this duty. 4 4. Develop state energy conservation policy and manage federal energy conservation 5 program activities between all levels of the public and private sectors regarding the 6 prudent and efficient use of energy resources. 7 5. Develop, implement, and administer federal categorical and block grant programs 8 assigned to the division. 9 6. Advise, coordinate, and assist cities, political subdivisions, and the state in all 10 phases of state and local planning for the physical development of the state.
 - 7. Render financial assistance to any government planning agency within federal law or regulation.
 - 8. Advise, consult, coordinate, assist, and contract with or on behalf of the various planning agencies in developing and harmonizing planning activities of the state.
 - 9. Implement a state facility energy improvement program.
- 16 10. Adopt rules implementing energy efficiency construction standards for public
 17 buildings as otherwise provided by law.
