1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 51-31-04 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to law enforcement reports for individuals who are the victims of identity
3 theft.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 51-31-04 of the North Dakota
6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

7 1. An individual who has learned or reasonably suspects that the individual's personal
8 identifying information has been unlawfully used by another, as described in
9 section 12.1-23-11, may initiate a law enforcement investigation by contacting the
10 local law enforcement agency that has jurisdiction over the individual's residence
11 or any other jurisdiction in which any part of the offense occurred. The law
12 enforcement agency shall take a report of the matter, provide the individual with a
13 copy of that report, and begin an investigation of the facts. If the suspected crime
14 was committed in a different jurisdiction, the local law enforcement agency may
15 refer the matter to the law enforcement agency where the suspected crime was
16 committed for further investigation of the facts.
