4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-27-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code 5 is amended and reenacted as follows: 6 15.1-27-03.1. Weighted average daily membership - Determination. 7 For each school district, the superintendent of public instruction shall multiply by: 8 1.00 the number of full-time equivalent students enrolled in a migrant summer a. 9 program; 10 1.00 the number of full-time equivalent students enrolled in an extended b. 11 educational program in accordance with section 15.1-32-17; 12 0.60 the number of full-time equivalent students enrolled in a summer C. 13 education program; 14 0.50 the number of full-time equivalent students enrolled in a home-based d. 15 education program and monitored by the school district under chapter 16 15.1-23; 17 0.25 0.30 the number of full-time equivalent students enrolled in an alternative 18 high school: 19 f. 0.25 the number of full-time equivalent students enrolled in an isolated 20 elementary school; 21 0.25 the number of full-time equivalent students enrolled in an isolated high g. 22 school: 23 h. 0.20 the number of full-time equivalent students attending school in a

The superintendent of public instruction shall determine each school district's 10 weighted average daily membership by adding the products derived under 11 subsection 1 to the district's average daily membership.
