1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for low-income student assistance grants.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$500,000, or so much
 of the sum as may be necessary, to the superintendent of public instruction for the purpose of
 providing grants to assist students from low-income families, for the biennium beginning July 1,
 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.
 - 1. In order to increase the likelihood that the students will graduate from high school in a timely manner and enroll in and graduate from either a two-year or a four-year institution of higher education, the superintendent may provide up to five grants, each in an amount not exceeding \$100,000, to public and private organizations that provide support to students from low-income families.
 - 2. For purposes of this section, "support" includes:
 - Tutoring in mathematics, laboratory sciences, composition, literature, and foreign languages;
 - b. Personal, financial, and academic counseling;
- 17 c. Mentoring;
- d. Cultural enrichment; and
- e. The provision of work study opportunities.
