- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 19-03.1-23.2 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to mandatory terms of imprisonment for drug offenses.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 19-03.1-23.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 19-03.1-23.2. Mandatory terms of imprisonment Deferred or suspended
- 7 **sentence limited.** Whenever a mandatory term of imprisonment is prescribed as a penalty for
- 8 violation of this chapter, the court may not defer imposition of sentence, nor may the court
- 9 suspend any part of a specified mandatory term, either at the time of or after the imposition of
- 10 the sentence, unless the court first finds that the offense was the defendant's first violation of
- 11 this chapter, chapter 19-03.2, or chapter 19-03.4 and that extenuating or mitigating
- 12 circumstances exist which justify a suspension. The court shall announce the circumstances
- 13 that justify a suspension in open court when sentence is imposed and recite these
- 14 circumstances in the sentence or order suspending part of the sentence.
