BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA: 4

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 6 of section 37-17.1-06 of the North Dakota 6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 7 The division of homeland security, in coordination with lead and support agencies, 8 shall: 9 Coordinate the procurement of supplies, materials, and equipment during a. 10 disaster or emergency operations. 11 Provide guidance and standards for local disaster or emergency operational b. 12 plans. 13 Periodically review local disaster or emergency operational plans. C. 14 d. Coordinate state or state and federal assistance to local emergency 15 management organizations. 16 Establish and operate or assist local emergency management organizations 17 to establish and operate training programs and programs for emergency 18 public information. 19 f. Make surveys of industries, resources, and facilities, within the state, both 20 public and private, as are necessary to carry out the purposes of this chapter. 21 The use of sensitive and proprietary logistical data submitted to the state in 22 confidence by individual industries and suppliers must be accorded full 23 confidentiality and will be released only in aggregate form.

1 Plan and make arrangements for the availability and use of any private g. 2 facilities, services, and property, and, if necessary and if in fact used, 3 coordinate payment for that use under terms and conditions agreed upon. 4 h. Establish access to a register of persons with types of training and skills 5 important in prevention, mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery. 6 i. Establish access to a register of equipment and facilities available for use in a 7 disaster or emergency. 8 į. Prepare, for issuance by the governor, executive orders, proclamations, and 9 guidance as necessary or appropriate in managing a disaster or emergency. 10 k. Coordinate and may enter agreements with the federal government and any 11 public or private agency or entity in achieving any purpose of this chapter and 12 in implementing programs for disaster mitigation, preparation, response, and 13 recovery. 14 I. Be the state search and rescue coordinating agency, establish access to a 15 register of search and rescue equipment and personnel in the state, and plan 16 for its effective utilization. 17 Coordinate the adoption of nationally recognized standards for emergency m. 18 services providers, including fire departments, law enforcement, emergency 19 medical services, and public communications dispatchers. 20 Do other things necessary, incidental, or appropriate for the implementation of n. 21 this chapter. 22 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the 23 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$190,000, or so much 24 of the sum as may be necessary, to the adjutant general for the purpose of coordinating the 25 adoption of nationally recognized standards for emergency services providers, for the biennium 26 beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. The adjutant general is authorized one 27 full-time equivalent position for implementing the responsibility described in this Act.
