BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 8 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-15-13.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 43-15-13.2. Membership of North Dakota pharmaceutical association. The
 membership of the North Dakota pharmaceutical association consists of every person:
 - 1. Who has secured a current annual license to practice pharmacy in this state in accordance with this chapter and who has not requested a refund of a portion of the license fee under section 3 of this Act.
 - Who has paid an annual membership fee directly to the association as determined and permitted by the association and who does not hold a current license to practice pharmacy in this state.
- 18 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-15-13.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 43-15-13.4. Moneys payable from board of pharmacy to North Dakota pharmaceutical association. The board shall submit to the association shall annually receive fifty percent of fees received by the board for annual renewal licenses as a pharmacist in this state. The association may use the funds for payment of expenses of the association including relating to continuing pharmaceutical education, pharmacist discipline, the impaired pharmacist

1 program, matters related to pharmacist registration standards, and professional service 2 standards, and general operating expenses. The amount provided in this section must be paid quarterly to the association by the board. The association may not receive from the board any 3 4 portion of fees from out-of-state pharmacists who do not have a renewal license to practice 5 pharmacy in this state and may not receive any portion of examination fees, permit fees, or other fees or funds not specified in this section. 6 7 **SECTION 3.** A new section to chapter 43-15 of the North Dakota Century Code is 8 created and enacted as follows: 9 _____ The board shall provide each pharmacist and each applicant for licensure as a pharmacist information instructing the pharmacist or applicant that the individual 10 11 may apply to the board for a refund of fifty percent of the fee paid by the individual to the board 12 for licensure or a renewal of licensure if the individual elects to not become a member of the North Dakota pharmaceutical association. A request for a refund must be submitted within 13 14 thirty days after the individual pays the individual's examination or license renewal fees to the 15 board.
