- 1 A BILL to provide for a legislative council study of solid waste management, with an emphasis
- 2 on the siting and zoning of landfills on a statewide or regional level while allowing adequate
- 3 protection for political subdivisions and property owners.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

## 5 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY OF SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT.

- 6 During the 2009-10 interim, the legislative council shall study solid waste management, with an
- 7 emphasis on the siting and zoning of landfills on a statewide or regional level while allowing
- 8 adequate protection for political subdivisions and property owners in the siting and zoning
- 9 process. The study also may include the incorporation of information dealing with new solid
- 10 waste sciences that affect the overall issue of siting, the reduction of landfill waste in North
- 11 Dakota through the encouragement and coordination of public and private recycling programs,
- 12 and the potential for development of methane processing from landfills for power generation.
- 13 The legislative council shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any
- 14 legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-second legislative
- 15 assembly.
