- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 39-29-09 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the operation of off-highway vehicles.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 39-29-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - 1. An individual may not operate an off-highway vehicle on the roadway, shoulder, or inside bank or slope of any road, street, or highway except as provided in this chapter. Except in emergencies, an individual may not operate an off-highway vehicle within the right of way of any controlled-access highway. An individual may operate a registered off-highway vehicle on a gravel, dirt, or loose surface roadway. An individual may operate a registered off-highway vehicle on a paved highway designated and posted at a speed not exceeding fifty-five miles [88.51 kilometers] per hour an individual may operate a registered off-highway vehicle with a solid hitch on the front of the vehicle designed to attach to a farm tractor on a paved highway designated and posted at a speed not exceeding sixty miles [104.61 kilometers] per hour. A licensed driver over sixteen years of age may operate a registered class III off-highway vehicle on a paved highway designated and posted at a speed not exceeding sixty-five miles [104.61 kilometers] per hour.
