1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-03-35 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to the use of social security numbers on game and fish licenses and permit.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-03-35 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **20.1-03-35. Social Use of social security number to be furnished.** The social
7 ~~security number of an~~ director shall issue a distinguishing number to each applicant for any a
8 license or permit issued under this chapter which must be recorded on the application unless
9 the applicant is a foreign national to whom no social security number has been issued. A social
10 security number recorded under this section is confidential. Beginning on January 1, 2008, any
11 application that is printed in paper form for a resident or nonresident fishing, hunting, or
12 fur bearer certificate must be printed in a manner so that only the last four digits of the
13 applicant's social security number are recorded on the application, and the first five digits of the
14 applicant's social security number are not recorded on the application the director may not
15 issue a distinguishing number that is, contains, can be converted to, or is an encrypted version
16 of the applicant's social security number unless specifically requested by the applicant.
