- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-03-35 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the use of social security numbers on game and fish licenses and permit.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-03-35 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 20.1-03-35. Social Use of social security number to be furnished. The social security number of an director shall issue a distinguishing number to each applicant for any a license or permit issued under this chapter which must be recorded on the application unless
- 9 the applicant is a foreign national to whom no social security number has been issued. A social
- 10 security number recorded under this section is confidential. Beginning on January 1, 2008, any
- 11 application that is printed in paper form for a resident or nonresident fishing, hunting, or
- 12 fur-bearer certificate must be printed in a manner so that only the last four digits of the
- 13 applicant's social security number are recorded on the application, and the first five digits of the
- 14 applicant's social security number are not recorded on the application the director may not
- 15 <u>issue a distinguishing number that is, contains, can be converted to, or is an encrypted version</u>
- 16 of the applicant's social security number unless specifically requested by the applicant.
