BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. REGIONAL PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION PILOT PROJECTS. The department of transportation shall develop two transit coordination pilot projects in two of this state's planning regions. The department shall implement one pilot project in 2009 and one pilot project in 2010. Each pilot project must have a regional coordination administrator who coordinates the provision of transit services to the residence of the region in a manner that is cost-effective, efficient, and reduces fragmentation and duplication of services. The regional coordination administrator shall assist communities in transit planning in the specified region to develop a structure that will support coordinated transit. The department shall develop standards for transit providers and contractors who provide transit within the coordinated system. These standards must promote transit coordination among transit departments. The department shall prepare a four year statewide transit coordination plan to address the transit needs of residents in this state which is compatible with local government comprehensive plans, and ensures the most cost-effective and efficient method of providing transportation to individuals. The department shall complete and provide a report on the plan to the legislative council during the 2009-10 interim.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$375,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of transportation for two regional public transportation pilot projects, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011
