- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 4-35.1-03 and 4-35.1-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to agricultural chemigation requirements.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 4-35.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

- 6 4-35.1-03. Rules Standards for application through irrigation system,
- 7 installation, maintenance, and modifications.
- 8 <u>1.</u> The agriculture commissioner shall adopt rules regulating chemigation through 9 irrigation systems in this state to minimize the possibility of chemical, pesticide, 10 fertilizer, or other contamination of irrigation water supply and other rules as 11 necessary to implement this chapter. <u>The rules required under this subsection</u> 12 <u>must:</u>
- 13 <u>a.</u> Provide that there be two check valves on any irrigation system;
- 14b.Provide that chemigation tanks have a secondary containment system such15as a dike or a concrete enclosure; and
- 16c.Prohibit the storage of chemicals within scientifically justifiable setback17distances from water sources.
- 18 <u>2.</u> The commissioner may establish by rule adopt rules establishing standards for:
- 19 <u>a.</u> <u>The</u> application of pesticides and fertilizers through irrigation systems; for
- 20b.The installation and maintenance of all equipment and devices used for21chemigation purposes; for modifications
- 22 <u>c.</u> <u>Modifications</u> or changes in design, technology, or irrigation practices; or for

10	discovers any violation of this chapter that is discovered in the course of the state engineer's or	
11	the department's regular inspections of irrigation systems using chemigation, the inspecting	
12	entity shall inform the commissioner.
