- 1 A BILL for an Act to create a parks and recreation department county park matching grant pilot
- 2 program; and to provide an appropriation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. COUNTY PARK MATCHING GRANT PILOT PROGRAM. The parks and
- 5 recreation department shall establish a county park matching grant pilot program for the
- 6 biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. The department may select up to
- 7 ten counties to participate in the program. Each county selected is eligible to receive a grant of
- 8 up to \$250,000 for creating new county parks. Each grant award requires one dollar of county
- 9 matching funds for each two dollars of grant funding provided for the new county park project.
- 10 Grant funds may be used for the purchase of land; buildings to house showers and bathrooms;
- 11 and infrastructure, including water, sewer, and electrical service.
- 12 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
- 13 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$2,500,000, or so
- 14 much of the sum as may be necessary, to the parks and recreation department for the pilot
- program established in section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and
- 16 ending June 30, 2011.
