- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new chapter to title 12.1 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to human trafficking; and to provide a penalty.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new chapter to title 12.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 5 and enacted as follows:

<u>1.</u>	"Blackmail" means a threat to expose any fact or alleged fact tending to cause
	shame or to subject any individual to hatred, contempt, or ridicule.

9 2. "Debt bondage" means the status or condition of a debtor arising from a pledge by

10 the debtor of the debtor's personal services or those of an individual under the

11 debtor's control as a security for debt, if the value of those services as reasonably

assessed is not applied toward the liquidation of the debt or the length and nature
of those services are not respectively limited and defined.

<u>"Forced labor or services" means labor or services, including services involving</u>
<u>sexual acts, as defined in chapter 12.1-20-02, that are performed or provided by</u>
another individual and are obtained or maintained through an actor's:
