- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 39-06.1-11 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to an employer's vehicle permit for suspended drivers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 39-06.1-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an employer may apply to the department for a permit to allow an employee with a suspended license to be licensed after seven days of the suspension period have passed to operate the employer's vehicle within the scope of employment and between 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. The permit issued to the employer is limited to a vehicle allowed to be operated under a class D license and must be carried in the vehicle that is operated by the employee. The application for the permit must contain the name of the employer that is on the registration of the vehicles to be driven, the operator's license identification number of the employee, and must be accompanied by a fee of ten dollars.
