- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 6-09 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to Bank of North Dakota low interest loans for teachers.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 6-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 **Low interest loan Teachers.** 
  - 1. The Bank shall provide a loan to an eligible individual at an interest rate of four percent and with a repayment period of fifteen years. The proceeds must be used by the individual exclusively to pay off the individual's existing student loans.
- 10 <u>2.</u> To be eligible for a loan under this section, an individual must be:
- 11 a. A resident of this state;
  - b. Licensed to teach by the education standards and practices board; and
- c. Employed full-time as a teacher in this state.
- The total amount to which an eligible individual is entitled under this section is fifty
  thousand dollars.
- The Bank may assess a service fee for administering the loan and may establish
  terms and conditions necessary to effect this section.
