- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-06.2 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to nonresident commercial driver's licenses; and to amend and reenact
- 3 section 39-06.2-08 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to an application for a
- 4 commercial driver's license.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-06.2-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows:

When the holder of a commercial driver's license changes the holder's name or 11 mailing address, an application for a duplicate license must be made as provided in 12 section 39-06-18. 13 No person who has been a resident of this state for thirty days may drive a 3. <u>5.</u> 14 commercial motor vehicle under the authority of a commercial driver's license 15 issued by another jurisdiction. 16 4.<u>6.</u> Any person who knowingly falsifies information or certifications required under 17 subsection subsections 1 or 3 is subject to suspension, revocation, or cancellation 18 of the person's commercial driver's license for a period of at least sixty consecutive 19 days. 20 **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 39-06.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is 21 created and enacted as follows: 22 Nonresident license. 23 The department may issue a nonresident commercial driver's license to a resident 1. 24 of a foreign jurisdiction if the director has determined that the commercial motor 25 vehicle testing and licensing standards in the foreign jurisdiction do not meet the 26 testing standards established by 49 C.F.R. Part 383. 27 2. An applicant must surrender any nonresident commercial driver's license issued by 28 another state. 29 3. Before issuing a nonresident commercial driver's license, the department must 30 establish the practical capability of disqualifying the person under the conditions 31 applicable to a commercial driver's license issued to a resident of this state.

<u>4.</u>	"Nonresident" must appear on the face of a license issued under this section.
<u>5.</u>	Except as otherwise provided by this section, a nonresident commercial driver's
	license other than a temporary nonresident commercial driver's license expires on
	the earlier of the expiration date of the visa presented under subsection 3 of
	section 39-06.2-08, or the expiration date of the form I-94 arrival/departure record,
	or a successor document, presented under subsection 3 of section 39-06.2-08.
<u>6.</u>	The department may issue a temporary nonresident commercial driver's license to
	a person who does not present a social security card as required by section
	39-06.2-08 but who otherwise meets the requirements for a nonresident
	commercial driver's license, including the requirement that the commercial motor
	vehicle testing and licensing standards of the country of which the applicant is a
	resident not meet the testing and licensing standards established by 49 C.F.R,
	Part 383. A license issued under this subsection may not be renewed and expires
	on the earlier of the sixtieth day after the date the license is issued; the expiration
	date of the form I-94 arrival/departure record, or a successor document, presented
	under subsection 3 of section 39-06.2-08.
<u>7.</u>	The department may not issue more than one temporary nonresident commercial
	driver's license to a person.
<u>8.</u>	The fee for a nonresident commercial driver's license is one hundred twenty
	dollars. The fee for a temporary nonresident commercial driver's licenses id twenty
	dollars.
