## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-60 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

## Rural cultural center grants.

- 1. The department shall implement and administer a rural cultural center grant program. The department shall establish a board to award grants under this section. The board membership must include a representative of the state historical society of North Dakota, a representative of the division of tourism, and a representative of the division of community services.
- 2. An eligible applicant must submit to the department an application that establishes:
  - a. The applicant is an "economically viable small community" as defined under section 57-38-01.27;
  - <u>b.</u> A plan for establishment of or revision of a rural cultural center in the community which plan must include:
    - (1) A sustainable business plan that addresses future maintenance of the rural cultural center; and
    - (2) Information establishing the rural cultural center furthers historic preservation in the community and that the rural cultural center is a public benefit to the community;
  - <u>C.</u> Detailed documentation of the availability of one dollar of nonstate matching funds for each dollar of state funds awarded under this section; and

1 The applicant meets any additional requirements established by the d. 2 department. 3 The matching funds required under this section may include cash, in-kind assets, <u>3.</u> 4 or a combination of both. The maximum grant award under this section is seven hundred fifty thousand dollars. A grant under this section is not a business 5 6 incentive under chapter 54-60.1. 7 **SECTION 2.** APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the 8 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$3,000,000, or so 9 much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of commerce for the purpose of

providing rural cultural center grants under section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning
