- 1 A BILL for an Act to direct a legislative council study of the feasibility and desirability of
- 2 elimination of property taxes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. Legislative Council study of property tax elimination. During the
- 5 2009-11 interim, the legislative council shall study the feasibility and desirability of elimination of
- 6 property taxes. The legislative council examine the state revenues from all sources and
- 7 commitments of state funds and determine whether changes to the state taxation and spending
- 8 <u>structure would be appropriate to allow the state to eliminate property taxes and replace</u>
- 9 revenues for political subdivisions with revenues from state sources.
- 10 The legislative council shall report its findings and recommendations together with any
- 11 <u>legislation necessary to implement the recommendations to the sixty-second legislative</u>
- 12 <u>assembly.</u>
