The health information technology steering 6 7 committee and the information technology department s hall make recommendations to the health information technology office for implementing a statewide interoperable health 8 information infrastructure that is consistent with emerging national standards, promote the 10 adoption and use of electronic health records and other health information technologies, and 11 promote interoperability of health information systems for the purposes of improving health care 12 guality, patient safety, and the overall efficiency of health care and public health services. The 13 health information technology office shall provide or arrange for administrative services to assist 14 the health information technology steering committee. SECTION 4. HEALTH INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY OFFICE AND HEALTH
