- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 7 of section 19-03.1-23 of the North Dakota

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 7 of section 19-03.1-23 of the North Dakota

 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - Except as provided by section 19-03.1-45, a court may order a person an individual who violates this chapter or chapter 19-03.4 to undergo a drug addiction evaluation by a licensed addiction counselor. The court shall order an individual who violates this chapter or chapter 19-03.4 to undergo a drug addiction evaluation by a licensed addiction counselor if the offense occurred while the individual was operating a motor vehicle or in actual physical control of a motor vehicle and shall suspend the driving privileges of the individual for thirty days. The evaluation must indicate the prospects for rehabilitation and whether addiction treatment is required. If ordered, the evaluation must be submitted to the court before imposing punishment for a felony violation or a misdemeanor violation. If the individual is found to be in need of alcohol and substance abuse treatment and rehabilitation and that individual's license was suspended under this subsection, the court shall require the individual to complete alcohol and substance abuse treatment and rehabilitation as a condition of the return of driving privileges. The department may not return driving privileges unless the person provides evidence of satisfactory completion of treatment.
