- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative council study of factors impacting the cost of health
- 2 insurance.

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3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY HEALTH INSURANCE COST.
- During the 2009-10 interim, the legislative council shall consider studying the
 factors impacting the cost of health insurance. The factors considered in the study
 must include:
 - a. Minimum loss ratio;
- b. Three tier rating bands;
- 10 c. The effect of the federal Employee Retirement Income Security Act, Medicare,
 11 Medicaid, and the state children's health insurance program on individual and
 12 small group pricing;
 - d. Options for self-funding, fully insured funding, and combinations of these two methods of funding;
- e. Prepaid coverage versus risk coverage;
- 16 f. Corporate structure of health insurance companies;
- 17 g. Health insurance company subsidiaries;
- h. Rate, form, and reserve approval requirements;
- i. Statutory barriers to competition and lower costs;
- j. The role of health promotion versus risk coverage;
- 21 k. Transparency requirements based on tax incentive benefits;
- 22 I. Plan design or coverage options;
- 23 m. Health service mandates:
- n. Uninsured and underinsured North Dakotans;

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- o. Proposed federal changes in health care coverage; and
- p. Other health insurance cost and competition factors.
- 3 2. The legislative council shall report its findings and recommendations, together with
- 4 any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-second
- 5 legislative assembly.
