- A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability of encouraging the use of generic prescription drugs.
- WHEREAS, the quality of life of many North Dakotans depends in part on the availability of affordable prescription drugs; and
  - **WHEREAS**, prescription drug prices are increasing and methods to reduce prescription drug costs need to be studied; and
- WHEREAS, one method to reduce the cost of prescription drugs is to use generic
  prescription drugs, which are less expensive than brand name prescription drugs while being
  equally effective;
  - NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
  - That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of encouraging the use of generic prescription drugs; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
