HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the space and facility needs of
2 state agencies, including an evaluation of space leased by state agencies.

3 **WHEREAS**, the state of North Dakota leases office space in Bismarck for several of its
4 agencies and institutions; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the state of North Dakota maintains a State Capitol and Capitol complex
6 master plan; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the state should periodically evaluate office space needs and the cost of
8 leasing office space; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the state will realize efficiencies by effectively utilizing available space;

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
11 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

12 That the Legislative Council study state agency office space needs, including space
13 currently leased by state agencies, to determine if efficiencies can be realized; and

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
15 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
16 the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
