- 1 A concurrent resolution urging Congress to enact legislation to transfer lands around Lake 2 Oahe, excluding lands adjoining the Standing Rock Reservation, owned by the United States, 3 through the Army Corps of Engineers, to the state of North Dakota. 4 WHEREAS, the economy and well-being of the residents of North Dakota is dependent 5 upon agriculture; and 6 WHEREAS, the United States, through the Army Corps of Engineers, has acquired 7 certain lands around Lake Oahe; and 8 WHEREAS, the Army Corps of Engineers has failed to control weeds and manage this 9 land properly; and 10 WHEREAS, this failure to control weeds on land managed by the Army Corps of 11 Engineers is a public nuisance and jeopardizes the public health, safety, and general welfare of 12 the citizens of North Dakota; and 13 WHEREAS, this land would be better managed if it were under the control of the state 14 of North Dakota, through the Board of University and School Lands; 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 16 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
 - enact legislation to transfer lands around Lake Oahe, excluding lands adjoining the Standing Rock Reservation, owned by the United States, through the Army Corps of Engineers, to the state of North Dakota; and
