1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability
2	of modifying the health insurance rate filing and appeal process.
3	WHEREAS, maintaining a solvent and vibrant health insurance market in North Dakota
4	is imperative for our citizens; and
5	WHEREAS, escalating health care costs result in increasing health insurance
6	premiums; and
7	WHEREAS, adequate health insurance reserves are critical in protecting health
8	insurance policyholders from catastrophic events; and
9	WHEREAS, delays in the approval of health insurance premium rates and the length of
10	time for appeals of these rate decisions result in even higher health insurance premiums in the
11	future and unnecessary depletion of critical insurance reserves;
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
13	HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
14	That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of modifying the health
15	insurance rate filing and appeal process; and
16	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
17	recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
18	the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
