1 A concurrent resolution to create and enact a new section to the Constitution of North Dakota, 2 relating to the use of public property for political purposes. 3 STATEMENT OF INTENT 4 This measure prohibits the use of state or political subdivision property or services for political 5 purposes. 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE 7 SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 8 That the following proposed new section to the Constitution of North Dakota is agreed to 9 and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the primary election in 2010. 10 in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota. 11 SECTION 1. A new section to the Constitution of North Dakota is created and enacted 12 as follows: 13 A person may not use any property belonging to or leased by or any service that is 1. 14 provided to or carried on by the state or a political subdivision for any political 15 purpose. For the purposes of this section: 16 "Political purpose" means any activity undertaken in support of or in (1) 17 opposition to a statewide initiated or referred measure, a constitutional 18 amendment or measure, a political subdivision ballot measure, or the 19 election or nomination of a candidate to public office and includes using 20 "vote for", "oppose", or any similar support or opposition language in 21 any advertisement whether the activity is undertaken by any person. 22 "Political purpose" does not include: (2) 23 (a) Undertaking activities in the performance of a duty of a public 24 office or a position taken in any bona fide news story, 25 commentary, or editorial;

5		<u>b.</u>	"Property"	includes any item of value other than a public building leased or
6			hired as pe	rmitted by law.
7		<u>c.</u>	"Services"	includes the use of an employee during regular working hours for
8			which the e	employee has not taken annual or sick leave or other compensatory
9			leave.	
10	<u>2.</u>	This	section doe	es not limit the freedom of speech of any officer or employee of the
11		stat	e or a politic	al subdivision in that individual's personal capacity.
