1 A BILL for an Act providing an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the legislative branch

2 of state government; to provide for transfers; and to declare an emergency.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from the insurance
regulatory trust fund, not otherwise appropriated to the legislative branch of state government
for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that branch, for the fiscal period beginning with the
effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2011.

10 2011-13 biennium. The legislative council shall report to the appropriations committees of the

11 sixty-second legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium

12 beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

13 **SECTION 4. TRANSFERS.** Notwithstanding section 54-16-04, the director of the office 14 of management and budget and the state treasurer shall make transfers of funds between line items of appropriations for the legislative council as may be requested by the chairman of the 15 16 council or the chairman's designee upon the finding by the chairman or designee that the 17 nature of studies and duties assigned to the council requires the transfers in properly carrying 18 on the council's functions and duties. The director of the office of management and budget and 19 the state treasurer shall similarly make transfers of funds between the line items for the 20 sixty-first and sixty-second legislative assemblies, upon request by the chairman of the 21 legislative council or the chairman's designee upon the finding by the chairman or designee that 22 the transfers are required for the legislative assembly to carry on its functions and duties. 23 **SECTION 5. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
