SENATE BILL NO. 2001

1 A BILL for an Act providing an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the legislative branch
2 of state government; to provide for transfers; and to declare an emergency.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
5 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from the insurance
7 regulatory trust fund, not otherwise appropriated, to the legislative branch of state government
8 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that branch, for the fiscal period beginning with the
9 effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

the sixty-second legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE

BUDGET - REPORT TO SIXTY-SECOND LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the one-time funding items approved by the sixtieth legislative assembly for the 2007-09 biennium and the 2009-11 one-time funding items included in the appropriation for the legislative council in section 1 of this Act:

The 2009-11 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the 2011-13 biennium. The legislative council shall report to the appropriations committees of the sixty-second legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

SECTION 4. TRANSFERS. Notwithstanding section 54-16-04, the director of the office

of management and budget and the state treasurer shall make transfers of funds between line items of appropriations for the legislative council as may be requested by the chairman of the council or the chairman's designee upon the finding by the chairman or designee that the nature of studies and duties assigned to the council requires the transfers in properly carrying on the council's functions and duties. The director of the office of management and budget and the state treasurer shall similarly make transfers of funds between the line items for the sixty-first and sixty-second legislative assemblies, upon request by the chairman of the legislative council or the chairman's designee upon the finding by the chairman or designee that the transfers are required for the legislative assembly to carry on its functions and duties.

SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
